# Introducing the Southend Children, Young People and Family Public Health Service (SCYP & FPHS) and Parent Portal

We would like to re-introduce ourselves as your local School Nursing Team in Southend-on-Sea. We work across education and health with the aim of improving the health and wellbeing of children and young people and are part of the SCYP & FPHS within Southend City.

Your School Nursing team is now using the School Screener Parent Portal, an electronic method to communicate health information and results letters. In order to view your child's results, you will firstly need to register for a parent portal account.

In the portal you will find information about the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) which is something that children in Reception take part in each year. You will also have the opportunity to fill out a Health Questionnaire with your child, with the aim of finding out which, if any, areas we can support them with.

### What do I need to do?

- 1. Click the link below, this will take you to the registration landing page
- 2. Register for a school health parent portal account, using just an email address
- 3. Check your email inbox to create a password. It's important that you keep hold of your Username and password for future logins to access your child's results
- 4. Log into the portal to read further information about health programmes

Any information you give us is treated confidentially and is held securely. The information is used to plan and provide care and support for your child and will not be shared with the school or other children. If you do not wish to share any information with us, please let us know by opting out of the NCMP, this opt out ensures that we do not see your child for screening and any information will not be shared or used with other services.
